CONDITIONS OF PLAY AND GENERAL REGULATIONS

1. CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- a) The Competition shall be 72 holes Stroke Play over 2 days; 36 holes being played on the first day at Conwy Golf Course and the further 36 holes being played on the second day at Maesdu Golf Course.
- b) The winner shall be the Competitor who returns the lowest gross score over 72 holes. A tie for the main trophy will be decided on "sudden death" play off. Ties for all other prizes will be decided on the best card over the last 18, 9, 6, 3, 2, 1 holes as appropriate.
- c) The Joint Committee reserves the right to arrange and alter starting times.
- d) Any Competitor who is not present on the 1st Tee when called upon to start may be liable to disqualification.
- e) The Competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf of the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews, the Golf Union of Wales and such local rules of each respective Club as shall be approved by the Committee.
- f) It is a condition of the Competition that only those brands of 1.68 golf balls published in the current R. & A. Approved Lists are to be used under penalty of disqualification.
- g) Fellow Competitors will be allotted by the Committee.
- h) All disputes shall be settled by the Committee whose decision shall be final
- i) Only R. & A. conforming drivers are acceptable.

2. QUALIFICATIONS

To be eligible for entry a player must be:-

- a) Of amateur status as defined by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews.
- b) A subscribing member (of any age) of a "bona fide" Golf Club or Golfing Society in Great Britain.
- c) In possession of a handicap which does not exceed 5 (five) strokes under the Council of National Golf Unions Handicapping Scheme.

3. ENTRIES

- a) The total entries will be limited to 66 Competitors. In the event of applications exceeding this number, entries from players with higher handicaps will be decided by ballot which will take place immediately after the closing date for entries. The exact handicap received on the entry form will be that used for ballot purposes. All unsuccessful entrants will be informed without delay and entrance fees returned.
- b) All entries must be submitted online or sent on the form provided. Entries will not be accepted by telephone, unless the entry form is fully completed.
- c) All entries must be sent to the Joint Secretaries, c/o Conwy (Caernarvonshire) Golf Club, Morfa, Conwy, North Wales, LL32 8ER and must be accompanied by the entrance fee of £50, includes practice round at each club. Cheques to be made payable to "Aberconwy Trophy Golf Competition"
